PACIFIC WAVE

Pacific Wave is a horizontal stack of identical symbols that appears in size 1x2, 1x3 or 1x4. Empty spaces underneath it are filled with wild symbols.



GHOST BOX

The Ghost Box collects all symbols which are part of a win. Bigger symbols are broken apart and are collected as individual 1x1 symbols. When there are no more wins, the Ghost Box explodes and releases its collected symbols which are then dropped in again from above.
